

# **Thanksgiving**

Those who dissented from the state church, the established Church of England were persecuted. Some who wished to be separate from the Church of England and everyone else, thus known as Separatists, aka Puritans, fled to Leiden, Holland for the freedom to worship God as they wished. They soon discovered that their children were adopting the language and customs of Dutch children. Appalled at this distillation of their Puritan lives, these Puritans returned to England and made plans to sail to the New World. 102 Puritans set sail on the Mayflower from Southampton on September 06, 1620. Their destination was Virginia. Blown off course, they arrived at what is now Provincetown, Massachusetts at the beginning of what would be a bitter harsh winter.

Only half of the original 102 Pilgrims survived their first winter in the New World. If not for the help of the local indigenous peoples to teach them food gathering, farming and proper housing, all the Puritans might have perished. The following autumn, those 53 who survived celebrated the colony's first Fall Harvest along with 90 Wampanoag Native American people.

That Fall Harvest Feast lasted only a few years.

The first national Thanksgiving celebration was observed in honor of the new U.S. Constitution. In 1789, President George Washington issued a proclamation designating November 26<sup>th</sup> of that year as a "Day of Public Thanksgiving" to recognize the role of providence in creating the new United States and the new federal Constitution.

Between 1846-1863, influential author and editor of Godey's Lady's Book, Sarah Josepha Hale (author of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*), petitioned Congress and five different presidents (Zachary Taylor, Millard Fillmore, Franklin Pierce, James Buchanan and Abraham Lincoln) to create a national annual holiday for Thanksgiving. Sara Hale was from New England where, by the mid-19th century, celebrating and giving thanks for abundant autumn harvests was an established tradition. She finally had success when in 1863, President Abraham Lincoln declared Thanksgiving a national holiday on the last Thursday in November. President Lincoln's proclamation urged the nation to heal its wounds and restore "peace, harmony, tranquility and Union."

Sarah Josepha Hale prevailed upon President Lincoln to declare *Thanksgiving a National Holiday* and he did in 1863. Thus, Sarah Josepha Hale can be termed the "Godmother of Thanksgiving."

The Battle of Gettysburg (July 01 - 03, 1863) was the turning point of the Civil War pointing to an eventual Union victory. President Lincoln proclaimed the last Thursday of November, November 26, 1863, as a day to thank God and thank the Army for emerging successfully from the Battle of Gettysburg and called upon his countrymen to "set apart and observe the last Thursday of November, as a day of Thanksgiving and Praise."

The last Thursday of November settled in American's minds as Thanksgiving Day. The day after Thanksgiving became the day of shopping in preparation for Christmas. But, in 1939 when the last Thursday of November was the fifth Thursday in November leaving only some 24 days for Christmas shopping, President Franklin Roosevelt declared the third Thursday of November as Thanksgiving at the behest of business leaders. That created such a controversy that in 1941, the president and Congress fixed Thanksgiving as the fourth Thursday of November where Thanksgiving remains to this day.

Mariachis will begin Las Mañanitas with a musical tribute beginning at 7:15 in church that morning. About 8:00 AM, we will have a brief narrative/pageant recounting the beautiful and tender story of Our Lady of Guadalupe, the four times Our Lady intercepted St. Juan Diego. And when he asked for a sign, left Her Image on St. Juan Diego's Tilma which hangs, after all these centuries, on the wall of the Basilica atop Tepeyac Hill, northeast of the center of Mexico City in Mexico.

At 8:15 AM the mariachis will introduce the Mass.

After Mass, we will enjoy some refreshments. Please add to our reception any of the following: tamales, champurrado, pan dulce, café, cupcakes; paper plates, plastic utensils, napkins, paper cups (for hot and cold beverages).
